The banners will be blessed and then brought on pilgrimage to the Amex stadium for the 50th celebrations. It will be like bringing the heart of the Diocese to the Amex. Both Cardinal Cormac Murphy O'Connor and the previous Archbishop of Canterbury, Rowan Williams will be there.

Have you ever thought what it might be like to do a pilgrimage as our medieval forbears did, walking the journey in prayer, fun and fellowship though a lovely example of God's creation, a path that has been used by pilgrims for centuries.

Saturday	Mass then walk across the South Downs to - Evening: Sussex University Sports Centre – celebrations still being planned.
Sunday	Process with banners into the Amex Stadium for the Festival 50 celebrations.
